

Bottom Line: "Your work can be your worship" **Key Scripture**: Ephesians 1:20-23, 5:1-2, 15-17, Colossians 4:2-6

Engage

When you read about the events around Isaiah and how he told God to send him without knowing what he was being asked to do. Isaiah didn't ask for any details. He didn't ask God where, or when, or what would happen. He didn't ask for the details or the benefits. He didn't ask if it would be easy or if he would enjoy it. His answer was "YES" first, then "what are we going to do." (Isaiah 6:8)

- 1. Have you ever had a moment in your life when you said "yes" first and then got the details later? Explain what happened.
- 2. Why do we become so hesitant do go all in, in all ways for Jesus?

Unpack

Take a moment and read through *Ephesians 1:20-23, 5:1-2, and 15-17.*

- 3. What is something that sticks out to you in these verses?
- 4. Read through Colossians 4:2-6 and talk about what sticks out to you in these verses.

When we start to change our focus, connect our faith, and complete our mission God has for us, we start to realize that God has us right where we need to be to do what He needs us to do. Our work becomes worship back to Him. When our focus, faith, and mission becomes a part of who we are, we can do what God has set us up to do.

- 5. What are some way you struggle to connect your faith and your work? Or ways you connect them well.
- 6. How can this group help you Change, Connect, and Complete so you can make Jesus about every part of your life?
