Key Scripture:
Romans 6:1-14, John 1:14,
Isaiah 53:5

Engage

People look at sin very differently. Some look at it as “silly”, or this list of “everything you can’t do”. Some people laugh and boast about their sinful deeds not realizing the seriousness of it. Others know it’s wrong but just overlook it. Some people are in so deep that they can’t see a way out. Still some take it seriously but miss God and become legalistic about it. No matter what people may say, Jesus says its cost is death.

Apply

Things like “You’re blessed when you’re persecuted”, “Love your enemy”, “Don’t worry” or what we shared this past week “take sin seriously”.
